- * A collection of fine Vietnamese Lacquer Paintings with some oils
- * The works of four Vietnam lacquer painters go on display at The Lee Gardens, Causeway Bay from Friday 12th May – the exhibition opens daily 10.00am to 7.00pm until Thursday 25th May.
- * Titled ESSENTIALLY LACQUER, the exhibition illustrates the many facets of beautiful Vietnamese lacquer artworks from the Hanoi art community with an emphasis on modern lacquer painting techniques.
- * The works by Pham Thi Nghia & Tran Huy Quang are of particular interest. This husband and wife team have many talents – the works being shown in Hong Kong represent a small part of their versatile portfolio. The couple have two children, who are also talented artists.
- * Perhaps the most striking, are the humorous portraits of young woman by Ta Thi Thanh Tham. Painted on bright background, she creates pictures which are both interesting and portray a quiet body language through shape and eye movement.
- * To give the exhibition a modernistic balance, a selection contemporary lacquers by Ngo Thanh Nhan will be mounted together with the ever popular, oil on canvas paintings, by La Vuong.
- * The exhibition opens daily from 12th to 25th May 2006, will continue at the Asia Fine Art gallery, Duddell Street, Central.
