A sculptor of some repute, Tun Kyi specialized in works for monasteries and religious buildings most of his artistic life. This special talent enables him to see into nature, grab its essence and portray it so vividly on canvas through brush and palette knife.

Now 58, Tun Kyi lives with his family in Ngapali beach, Myanmar, facing the Indian Ocean, where he is inspired to bring his muse – sea – to life.
